

THE MAGIC OF GOZO



Gozo is one of the Mediterranean's best kept secrets. The second island in the Maltese archipelago, it has so much to offer the discerning traveller looking for a luxurious escape.

The landscape is stunning combining terraced hills like Bali, lush green colours in winter like Ireland, sheer cliffs on one side like Maui, carpets of spring wildflowers, traditional salt pans, the Inland Sea and Ramla Bay beach where turtles have started hatching again. In Gozo you can enjoy relaxation with yoga or sunbathing on the beach, to more active coastal walks and swimming in secret bays, through to extreme sports like cliff climbing.

Tara's studio is nestled in the tranquil Ta'Pinu valley leading down to the sea and home to the famous basilica. Clients get to enjoy these views and a sneak peek at the inside her fully accessible luxury Gozitan villa on their way to her studio.

The history of Gozo will also amaze. There are said to be some of the oldest manmade structures in the world (UNESCO world heritage site), standing stone circles, Punic temples, and ancient unexplained cart ruts.

Phoenicians and Romans brought viniculture, making Gozo one of the oldest wine growing regions in the world. The Maltese language and the main town is also





knows as Rabat indicating Arabic influences. The Knights of the Order of St John especially transformed Gozo when they fortified the hilltop Cittadella, which has awe inspiring views across the whole island. You can also see where Napoleon landed and the British also left their mark, as English is the second official language.

Music is everywhere on Gozo. Outstanding classical recitals by international musicians in impressive churches, modern music by the sea, and opera fans come from around the world for performances at the two opera houses. Festa's are where Gozitans let their hair down and enjoy music performed by their own village's brass band and fireworks which would not look out of place on Sydney Bridge at New Years.

But what makes Gozo even more extraordinary is the multi-cultural population, of whom so many are artists inspired by the island and its tranquillity. These include both undiscovered and internationally acclaimed painters, contemporary artists, ceramicists, glass blowers, sculptors, mosaic artists and of course, Tara and her jewellery.

To stay, there are boutique hotels, converted farm houses and several 5* hotels on the island. The Kempinski, a short walk from the Tara Lois Jewellery studio, recommends Tara to their guests looking for a luxury designer jewellery experience.

DESIGNING YOUR EXCLUSIVE JEWELLERY



Tara designs for clients around the world, and hand crafts the jewellery in her studio.

Those who come to Malta receive a sneak preview of her fully accessible luxury villa with stunning views over the Ta'Pinu Valley to the sea.

The design experience starts with a tour of her studio before moving into the Conservatory Room, where clients can choose from a range of beverages including premium Maltese wine.

Ideally, clients will have started an online conversation with Tara before arriving in Gozo, especially if they would like her to remodel their heirloom jewellery. Then they can decide what to bring with them.

If possible Tara will already have designs prepared, ready to discuss.



What to expect:

- The initial consultation is complimentary. It is an opportunity for you to meet Tara.
- Tara will ask about your commission, special memories, hopes, the sentimental value of old jewellery and your budget.

Design phase:

- You receive 3 initial designs on digital mood boards. You may choose one of these or ask for an additional revision.
- Once you approve a final design Tara will establish the cost and timing.

Hand crafting your design:

 Tara remains in regular contact with updates and photos until completed.

Shipping:

 We ship using the same company as Ferrari, at the client's expense.

- Classes can be booked from the <u>Tara Lois</u> <u>Jewellery Website Workshop Page</u>.
- Scheduled workshops last about 4 hours.
- People per class: 2 minimum/4 maximum.
- It is possible to request Private Workshops:
 - on alternative dates
 - exclusive experiences for couples
 - make your own wedding rings
 - arrangements for larger groups up to 6 people, eg hen parties making bridesmaids gifts

What is included:

- Experience design development
- · Introduction to jewellery making and tools.
- · Shared use of tools.
- Help throughout the making process when needed.
- Polishing, hallmarking and gift packaging.
- · Soft drinks/beverages and cookies.
- Private Workshops only: lunch for full day workshops and wine/canapes while jewellery is being polished.

Health & Safety:

- Guests must come suitably dressed for the workshop in closed shoes, trousers and clothes which may become damaged.
- Minimum age: 14 years, with adult.
- Any guests deemed by Tara to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be asked to leave without any refund.
